#### **Ordinance 150.101 - Cleanliness Of Premises**

A) Every owner of a dwelling containing two or more dwelling units shall be responsible for maintaining in a clean and sanitary condition such dwelling units and the shared or public area of the dwelling premises thereof. Every occupant of a dwelling containing less than two units shall be responsible for maintaining in a clean and sanitary condition the shared or public area of the unit and premises thereof.

B) Every occupant of a dwelling unit shall keep in a clean and sanitary condition that part of the dwelling unit, facilities, yard, and otherwise, all premises which he or his family occupies, uses, or controls.

**Several large dumpsters will be placed at the corner of 13<sup>th</sup> and East Spring St. for the disposal of large items or any other garbage.**

**If you choose not to participate in the Neighborhood Clean-up Day and you have garbage or other items that violate the Cleanliness of Premises ordinance your address will be turned over to the City of New Albany for citation and further action!**
